The Healthy Families program at **Old Mill Center for Children and Families** is hiring for the following position:

Healthy Families Program Manager (0.9 FTE, 36 hours/week)

This position is responsible for the overall management of the Healthy Families program in Benton and Linn counties including supervision of all program supervisors, ongoing collaboration with community and state partners and oversight of the Healthy Families program budget. The Program Manager is responsible for maintaining high quality standards of service provision and protecting the integrity and respect of families served and ensures all policies and procedures for the Healthy Families program and Old Mill Center (OMC) are followed.

Master's degree in public health or human services administration or fields related to working with children and families including experience in quality assurance/improvement and site development, or Bachelor's degree with 3 years of relevant experience required. The ideal candidate needs a solid understanding and experience in managing, supervising, supporting and motivating staff. Knowledge of infant/child development and parent child attachment as well as a strong background in prevention services to the 0-3 age population is desirable. Experience with home visiting and providing services to culturally diverse communities embracing the concepts of family-centered and strength-based service provision is helpful. Infant Mental Health Endorsement is preferred.

Pay range is \$ 24.00 to \$26.00 hour depending on training and experience. OMC offers benefits including paid personal leave, health insurance and holidays. Pre-employment criminal background check is required.
