Must have early childhood knowledge/ability to respond appropriately to each child's developmental level, to nurture and support each child's social & emotional skills; to form positive relationships with families; flexibility, good organizational skills; and the willingness to work as an engaged, supportive member of a team. Experience/background working with families with multiple stressors is helpful. In addition, must have an agreement with the OMCCF and Relief Nursery missions.
