Position Summary: The Unlicensed Child and Family Therapist (UCFT) provides mental health services to children ages 3 to 18 years old and their families.

Qualifications and Experience:

1. Education

Masters' Degree in Counseling, Psychology, or another related field, which in combination with experience, qualifies the candidate to be a Qualified Mental Health Professional as defined in Oregon Administrative Rules.

2. Experience and Abilities:

Two years of experience working with children and families in a clinical or related setting, clinical internship and volunteer work is applicable and can be combined to meet the experience expectations. Experience working with young children and their families required. Strong computer skills and the ability to document services in an Electronic Health Record required. Able to pass required background checks.

3. Licensure:

It is desirable that the incumbent is eligible for registration as an intern (Associate) with the respective board working towards licensure for a Licensed Professional Counselor, Licensed Clinical Social Work and/or a Marriage and Family therapist (LMFT).

- Case management and care coordination
- Skills training
- Psychoeducation
